This letter is to notify you that the Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) has received the information you reported on the *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) for the 2010-11 academic year. The award letter from the college will be your only notification as to whether you will be receiving a MAP grant for 2010-11.

The total number of MAP Paid Credit Hours that you have used is listed in the field entitled "YOUR MAP PAID CREDIT HOURS USED" at the top of this letter. Please note that any payments processed on your behalf after the "AS OF" date listed above will increase the number of "YOUR MAP PAID CREDIT HOURS USED" as reported on this letter.

In order to be considered for a full-year MAP grant for the next academic year, file your 2011-12 FAFSA (which becomes available on January 1, 2011 as early as possible. Please be aware that grant funding could be depleted before all eligible applicants receive awards. For the quickest results, file electronically with FAFSA on the Web at **fafsa.gov**.
