

## 2011-12 ILLINOIS NATIONAL GUARD (ING) GRANT PROGRAM NOTIFICATION OF INELIGIBILITY

Based on information from the Department of Military Affairs Illinois (DMAIL) and/or Illinois Student Assistance Commission (ISAC) records, we have determined that you are not eligible for the 2011-12 Illinois National Guard (ING) Grant Program for the following reason(s):

- ( ) DMAIL reported that you are not a current member of the Illinois National Guard.\*
- ( ) DMAIL reported that you have not completed one year in the Guard and will not be eligible to participate in the ING Grant Program within the 2011-12 academic year.\*
- ( ) You have used the maximum 120 units of eligibility and are not eligible for educational benefits through the ING Grant Program for current or any future enrollment.\*\*

\* *It is your responsibility to contact your National Guard Unit regarding information provided to ISAC by DMAIL, Education/Incentives Branch. ISAC will notify you via mail if an update is received from DMAIL.*

\*\* Benefits cannot be extended beyond 120 units of eligibility. You may contact a College Zone Counselor regarding your history of benefits. It is your responsibility to work with the college(s) that received payment on your behalf to submit any corrections to ISAC. If a correction is received, ISAC will notify you via mail.

**Please note:** Updates/corrections must be made within the academic year. The college also has deadlines for requesting payment on a student's behalf. ISAC sets payment request deadlines in late November for fall term; mid-April for spring term and late June for summer term. The college may have earlier deadlines for students to submit documentation of eligibility - you must work with your college's financial aid office for information about their deadline dates.

Failure to present an eligibility letter to the college may result in the loss of benefits.
